History of Olaus and Thea by Charlotte Stausberg

Olaus married first wife - Hailer
had 2 children Arrin and Ruth ^{Conrad} Sakke
he died and she married Gunnar Nykamper.

After first wife's death he wrote to
Thea's father and asked if he would
send one of his daughters (Thea, Maria or
Mathea) to come and live and care for
his 2 children. Mathea was already in
America. Thea and Maria came by boat
which Olaus and neighbor man sponsored
the girls.

They were most poor in Norway. Thea's
father was a chimney sweeper. Thea came
to America at the age of 20. She has worked
for a ~~hog~~ hog farmer in Norway, sitting
with the swine all night when they bore
their young.

When she left her home and told
her parents good by, her father was outside
chopping wood. She called good by to him.
He answered, Don't ever get married, Thea.

When arriving in Westby, Olaus met
them in ~~horse~~ ^{horse} and buggy. Got to his farm
he had a curtain between 2 beds. They
prepared supper while he went to Chose
his cows.

Maria worked for and married the neighbor man. She died with flu at child birth.

Olaus was quite an alcoholic before he accepted Christ into his heart. Then he and 2 men (Melvin Erickson and Dennis Hoiler) started Bethesda Lutheran Brotherhood Church in Nestby, where his son LaLerne was baptized & confirmed, also LaLerne's children Randy, Stevie and Rodney were baptized there. Rodney was also confirmed there. Pastor ~~Lindal~~ ^{L. Baylors} Jacobson officiated at LaLerne's baptism and Pastor Lindal Swan officiated at Rodney's.

Olaus & Inea would go to house parties when she first got here. He was a little man of stature, but when he danced the palka everyone would clear the floor. He could kick the ceiling.

Inea said she might as well ^{marry} ~~marry~~ him as he was so jealous, he wouldn't let anyone else dance with her.

There was a spring of water down in the woods where she would carry clothes and wash them hitting them with stones.

Inea was a beautiful strawberry blonde long hair and creamy color skin. Olaus was a red head turned brown, thin, grass - 2-

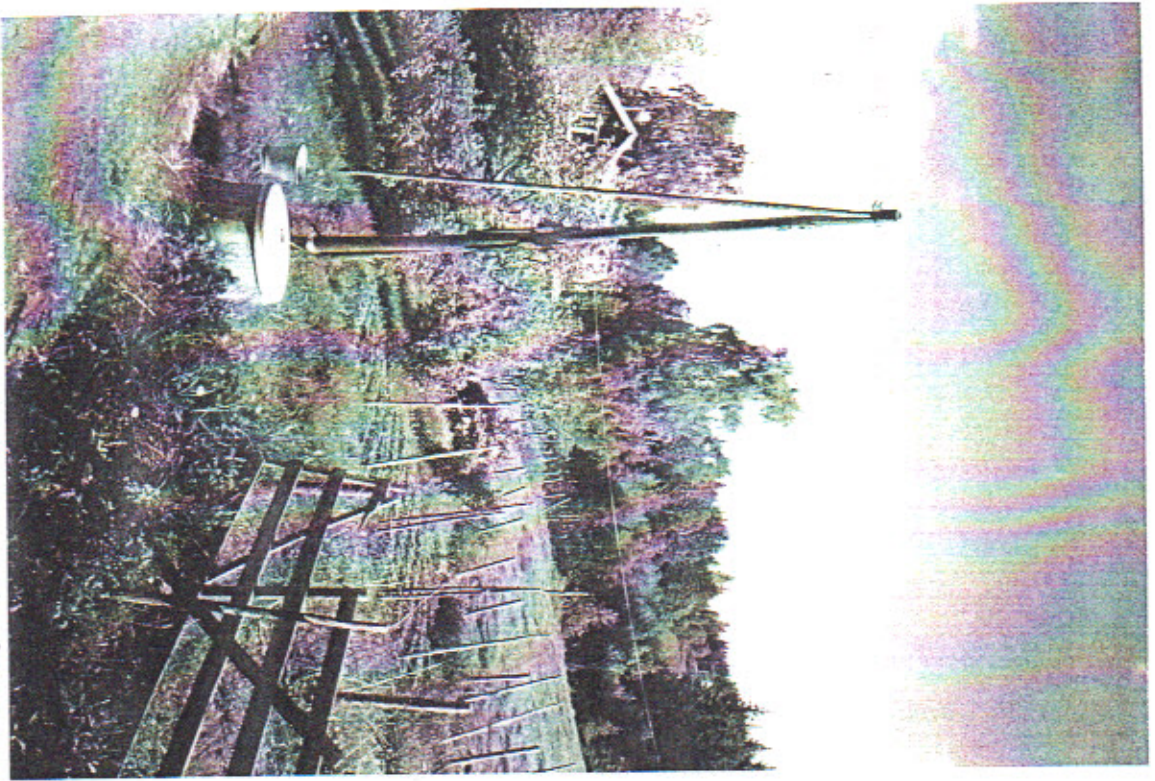

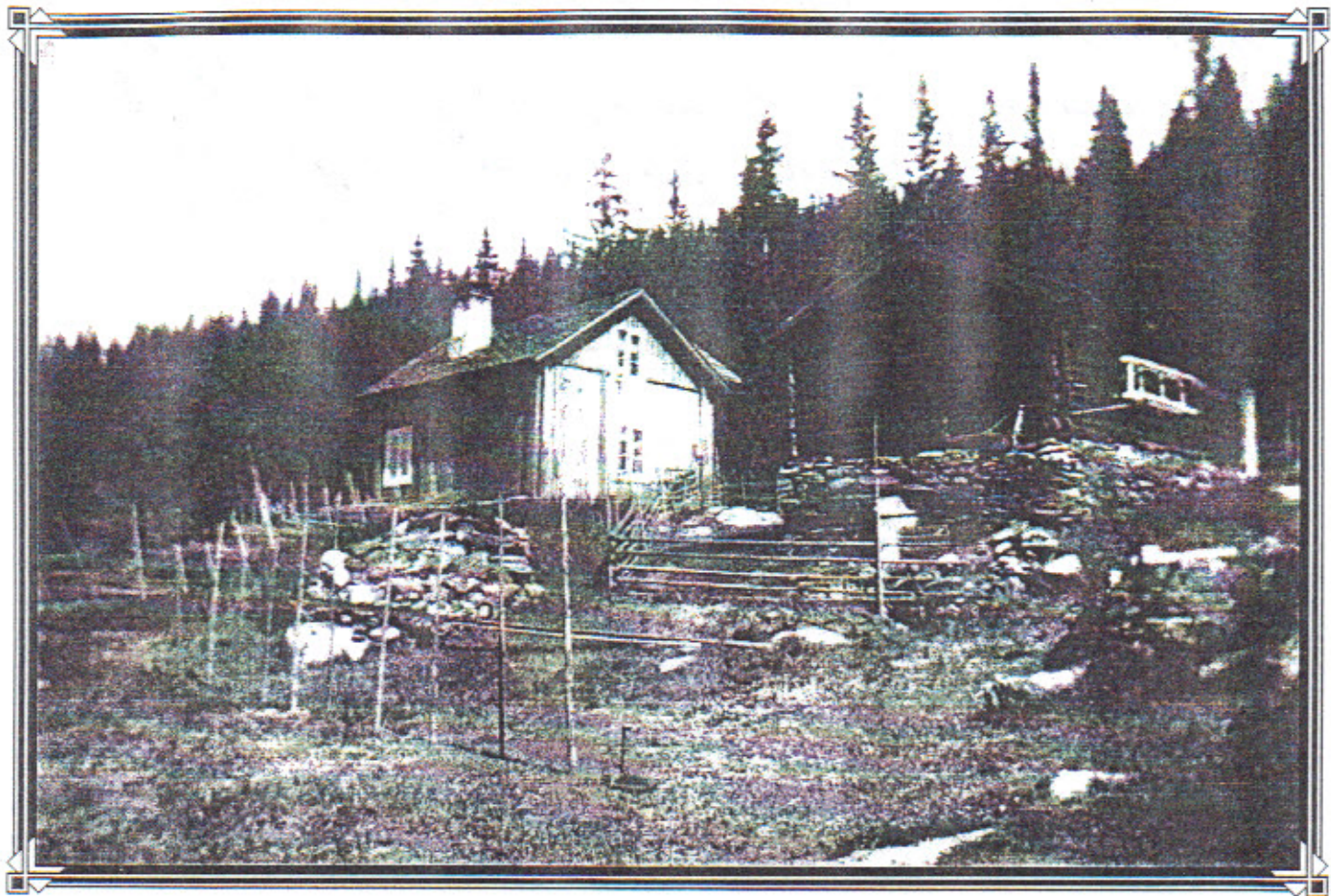

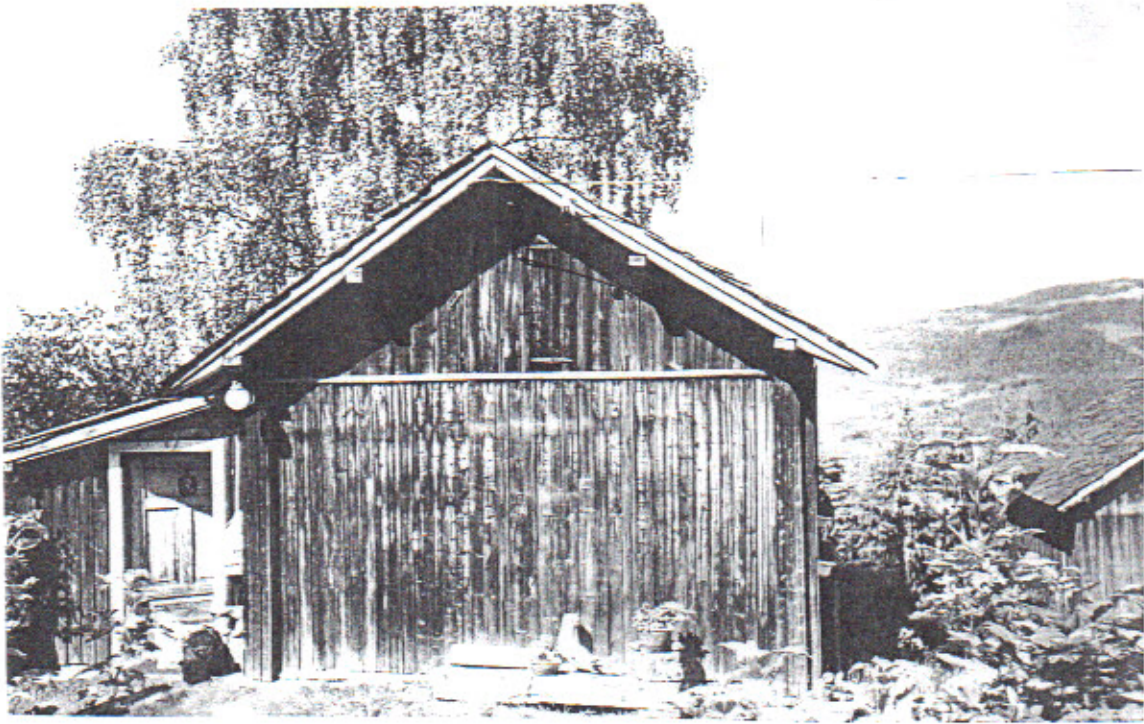
